Introduction

The question may arise, "*Why another evangelistic Bible study?*" Certainly, there are many good evangelistic studies available. Yet it seems that many of these evangelistic studies fall short of certain foundational truths to adequately lead someone to Christ. This study is loosely based on Acts 17:22-34 in that Paul was approaching a culture of people that were religious but did not have true knowledge of God or the Scriptures.

So what is different about this evangelistic study and what does it include?

Five Lessons

- 1) The Word of God is the authority and basis for learning about God and man.
- 2) God is established as Creator, therefore man is accountable to Him. Also, God's character is studied because man has a distorted view of God.
- 3) Man is shown his sinfulness by using the law, and man learns about the judgement and consequences of his sin.
- 4) The Gospel of Christ is studied, and man's need of responding in repentance and faith.
- 5) Following Christ comes at a great cost, and therefore one needs to understand the full ramifications of the responsibility to follow Christ. Just because someone prays a prayer or says they believe in Jesus, doesn't necessarily make them a Christian. True Christianity is a transformed life away from continuous sin to godliness that is seen in tangible fruit.
